Subj SUCCESSION OF COMMAND

Ref: (a U.S Navy Regulations 1973 Chapter 8

1. Purpose. To establish procedures to be followed at the Naval Medical Research Center Detachment, Lima, Peru for the succession of command in the absence of the Officer-in-Charge as outlined in reference (a).

2 Cancellation. NMRCD Instruction 5402.1C is hereby cancelled.

3. Background. When the Officer-in-Charge is absent from the command due to illness, annual leave or official temporary additional duty (TAD), for a period of 24 hours or more, an acting Officer-in-Charge shall be appointed in writing.

4. Policy. During the absence of the Officer-in-Charge the next most senior officer regardless of designator shall be appointed as acting Officer-in-Charge in accordance with reference (a).

5. Action. Prior to the Officer-in-Charge's departure, advance written notification shall be prepared appointing the acting Officer-in-Charge in accordance with provisions of reference (a).
